

Steer Beef Harvest Pricing

Pricing is based on hanging weight, the post-harvest weight of the steer after removal of non-retained portions during initial processing. This is also known as the carcass weight. The example below reflects a 711-pound hanging weight (total for both halves of the steer). All of the total prices below are estimates, the final prices will be determined by the actual hanging weight of your steer.
